About Samaritan Health Services

Samaritan Health Services, based in Corvallis, Oregon, is a nonprofit regional health system with more than 6,000 employees. Founded in 1997, the organization provides care to more than 290,000 residents in Benton, Lincoln, Linn and portions of Marion and Polk counties.

Driven by its mission to build healthier communities together, the system includes five hospitals, nearly 100 medical clinics, retail pharmacies and fitness centers. Samaritan offers health insurance plans, including locally administered Medicare Advantage plans, employer group plans and a Samaritan employee plan. Samaritan also administers the regional InterCommunity Health Network Coordinated Care Organization.

Samaritan prioritizes advancing medical education and addressing community-wide health concerns through partnerships with educational institutions, local nonprofits and public health departments. Nationally, Samaritan has been recognized for providing high quality care and as one of America's healthiest workplaces.

Good Samaritan Regional Medical Center

Good Samaritan Regional Medical Center is the largest of five hospitals affiliated with Samaritan Health Services. Its roots date back to the early 1900s as Corvallis General Hospital, becoming Good Samaritan Hospital in 1948.

Good Samaritan is one of five Level II trauma centers in Oregon and offers medical and surgical specialties including cancer services, cardiology, cardiothoracic surgery, neurosurgery, orthopedic and spine surgery, inpatient mental health care, pediatric hospitalists and a stroke Center of Excellence.

The hospital's mission to build healthier communities together is demonstrated through its quality of care, commitment to community partnerships and research, and training of future clinicians enrolled in the Graduate Medical Education program.

Samaritan Albany General Hospital

In the heart of Oregon's Willamette Valley, nestled in a charming historic neighborhood, Samaritan Albany General Hospital has been serving the community since 1924. The 79-bed nonprofit acute care hospital and network of medical clinics provides care to the greater Albany area.

Services offered include cardiology, diagnostic imaging, physical rehabilitation, maternity, general surgery, orthopedic care, infusion therapy, robotic-assisted surgery and a nationally recognized joint replacement program. The medical campus also includes specialty services such as sleep medicine, hyperbaric wound care, a cancer resource center and Sarah's Place, the first sexual assault nurse examiner center in Oregon, which provides treatment and resources to anyone who has experienced sexual assault or domestic violence.

The hospital's mission to build healthier communities together is demonstrated through its quality of care, commitment to community partnerships and research, and hospice services.



Samaritan Lebanon General Hospital

Located in East Linn County, Samaritan Lebanon Community Hospital has been a trusted provider of health care services for the rural residents of Lebanon, Sweet Home and Brownsville since 1952. As an accredited full-service, 25-bed nonprofit critical access hospital, it provides personalized, high-quality care.

The team of experienced professionals offers a comprehensive range of services including diagnostic imaging, general surgery, endoscopy, maternity, infusion, and a health and fitness center to meet the community's health care needs.

The hospital's mission to build healthier communities together is demonstrated through its quality of care, commitment to community partnerships and research, and training of future clinicians enrolled in local health care career programs.

Samaritan North Lincoln Hospital

Samaritan North Lincoln Hospital is a 16-bed accredited critical access hospital located on the shores of scenic Devils Lake in coastal Lincoln City, Oregon. It is part of Samaritan Health Services, a nonprofit network of hospitals, clinics and health services in the mid-Willamette Valley and central Oregon Coast.

Since 1968, the hospital and its associated clinics have been trusted providers of emergency, primary and specialty care to the diverse communities of north Lincoln County and its coastal visitors. It also operates Samaritan Early Learning Center, a preschool for infants, toddlers and children up to age 5. In February 2020, the hospital relocated to a new, state-of-the-art facility east of the original hospital.

Samaritan Pacific Communities Hospital

Samaritan Pacific Communities Hospital is an accredited 25-bed critical access hospital located between Yaquina Bay and the Pacific Ocean in Newport, Oregon. It is part of Samaritan Health Services, a nonprofit network of hospitals, clinics and health services in the mid-Willamette Valley and central Oregon Coast.

Since 1952, the hospital and its associated clinics have been trusted providers of emergency, primary and specialty care to the diverse communities of south and central Lincoln County. It also operates the Samaritan Center for Health Education, a regional hub for health-related activities and events. In 2019, the hospital underwent major redevelopment and expansion to ensure world-class care for decades to come.
