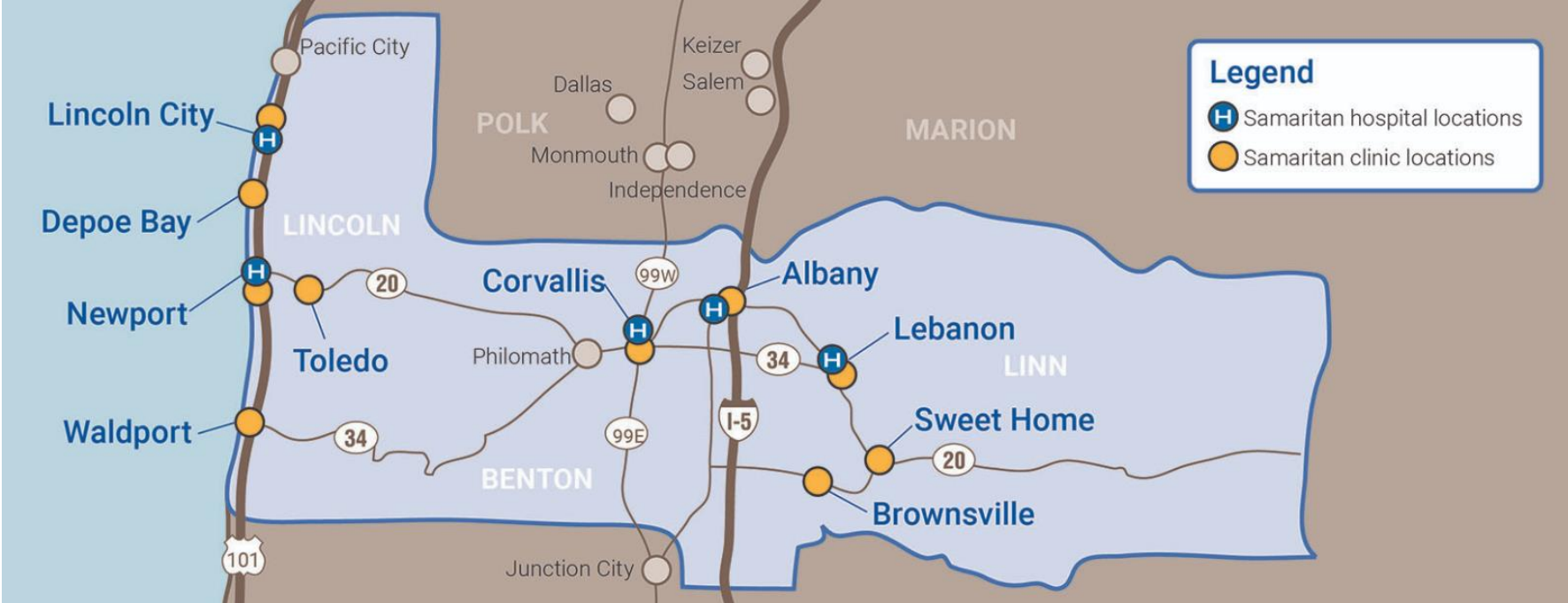

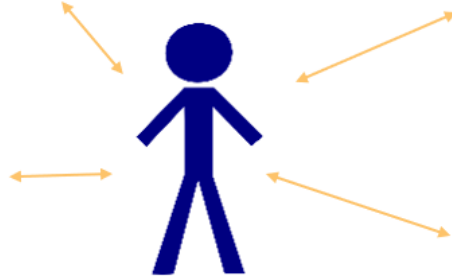

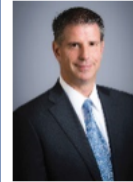

How to Apply

Apply using the National Administrative Fellowship Centralized Application Service (NAFCAS)

- 🔥 Cover Letter
- 🔥 Personal Statement
- 🔥 Resume
- 🔥 Three graduate letters of recommendation
- 🔥 Official graduate school transcript
- 🔥 Official or unofficial undergraduate transcript
- 🔥 Three 300-word essays (found on NAFCAS site)
- 🔥 Deadline to apply: September 26th



Interviews

Phone Screening: Each candidate will receive a phone call and be interviewed and asked a few questions with the current fellow

1st Round Interviews: Each of our top candidates will meet virtually via Teams and interview with both current and past fellows

2nd Round Interviews: Top candidates will participate in four rounds of in-person interviews with senior executives and members of the Administrative Fellowship Advisory Committee (AFAC) in Corvallis
