

## Good Samaritan Regional Medical Center Nursing Excellence Scholarship

The **Good Samaritan Regional Medical Center Nursing Excellence Scholarship** was established in 2013 in honor/memory of outstanding Registered Nurses (RNs) at Good Samaritan Regional Medical Center in Corvallis, Oregon.

The Nursing Excellence Scholarship is available to eligible students pursuing RN, BSN, or MSN degrees who show leadership and clinical expertise and excellence. At least one scholarship is awarded for tuition, books, and school fees.

### Eligibility

To be considered for a Nursing Excellence Scholarship, candidates must meet the following guidelines:

- Be enrolled or enrolling in the final year of an accredited nursing program.
- Be in good academic standing.
- Be a current [Samaritan Health Services](http://www.samhealth.org) employee in good standing (preferred).
- Be enrolled in an RN, BSN, or MSN program.

Nursing Excellence scholarships are available to individuals without regard to race, religion, national origin, gender, age, color, disability, or marital status.

### Application Process and Timeline

Application information is available to college financial aid/career planning staff, as well as on the Samaritan Health Services website ([www.samhealth.org](http://www.samhealth.org)).

#### **Completed applications are due April 1, 2026.**

Scholarship recipient(s) will be announced by July 2026.

Scholarship funds will be mailed in July 2026 in the recipient's name directly to the college/university indicated on the application. No funds will be released directly to the recipient.

Please submit by e-mail the following documents with your completed application form, all in Adobe PDF file format:

- \_\_\_ Personal essay.
- \_\_\_ Your most current college academic transcript.
- \_\_\_ A current resume, including previous employment, volunteer, and community service work.
- \_\_\_ Two letters of recommendation from non-family members (i.e., employer/volunteer supervisor or school counselor); one must be from a nursing instructor and another from a non-nursing instructor.
